

Meeting Your Driver at Delhi Airport — A Clear & Practical Guide

Before Departure

When speaking with your driver or booking agent, please share and confirm the following:

- 1 **Driver & Vehicle Details** — Full name, vehicle registration number, and if possible, photos of the vehicle and driver. *(STI24x7 provides these proactively.)*
 - 2 **Flight Number** — Share your exact flight number so the driver can track arrival time.
 - 3 **Identification Photo** — A picture of the lead traveller helps quick recognition.
 - 4 **Meeting Point** — Agree in two parts:
 - **Exit Gate** (usually Gate 4, 5, or 6)
 - **Pillar Number** (commonly 12, 13, 14, or 15)
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Rule 1 — Pause & Orient

Why it matters:

Rushing out **without driver confirmation** is the **leading cause** of missed connections and unnecessary waiting.

What to do:

1.  After collecting your baggage, take a moment to breathe, check your belongings, and ensure your companions are with you.
2.  Inform the driver that you are ready to exit. **Do not rush** — wait for the driver's arrival confirmation.
3.  Meet the driver at the agreed spot (commonly between Pillars 14 and 15).
4.  From there, the driver will guide you to the parking area.

 **Note:** Other-state-registered commercial vehicles are **not allowed** in the Arrivals vehicle lanes.

⚠️ **Disclaimer:** In the parking area, some individuals may offer unsolicited help with luggage and later request **foreign currency**. Politely decline unless you wish to use their service.

📌 Rule 2 — Know Your Exit Gate

Delhi Airport has multiple Arrivals exits. **Confirm your Exit Gate in advance** (Gate 4, 5, or 6). A mismatch can waste **10–15 minutes**, especially during heavy traffic.

📍 Rule 3 — Confirm the Meeting Point in Advance

Agree on **both** the Exit Gate **and** Pillar Number before travel day. This eliminates guesswork and prevents delays.

📍 Rule 4 — Be Ready for Phone/App Failures

Live location and calls help — but **network issues, battery drain, or unfamiliarity with apps** can cause delays. Always give **clear physical location info** so a meeting is possible **even without a phone**.

🧘 Rule 5 — Keep It Simple Under Stress

Long flights, heavy bags, and crowded terminals can cloud judgement. **Simple, short meeting instructions — confirmed in advance — prevent mistakes.**

✅ Final Tip:

Delhi Airport's Arrivals pickup area is busy, but if you **pause, orient, and agree on specifics before travelling**, you can meet your driver **quickly and stress-free** — with or without gadgets.
